Lay Director's Report:

School of Leaders

This Saturday we are hosting the third School of Leaders explaining the Step by Step leader's manual. All Cursillistas should attend, especially those who have a vested interest in how our weekends are conducted. (see above for details)

Second Touch

We just completed another wonderful Second Touch Weekend attended by 70 Cursillistas from Buffalo and a few from Rochester. This was a continuation of the "Living the Charism" series: It focused on "The beginning - Thursday Night". We covered the Thursday night schedule, rollos, and meditations learning what our founder Eduardo Bonnin's specific purpose was for each.

At the start we all introduced ourselves and answered the following question: "How did you feel or what were your thoughts when you arrived on Thursday night for your Cursillo weekend? Take a moment now to ask yourself that question.

As I would have expected, many said that they were excited and were looking forward to a spiritual experience. However, it was a revelation to me to hear that a great number, maybe even the majority said that they were nervous and felt uncomfortable. A couple dozen of the 70 said they did not want to be there and wanted to leave. Some felt pressured to attend by their spouse or their sponsor. Some felt trapped. Others did not like the fact that they were stuck for 3 days with 30 or 40 complete strangers. This was a real eye opener for me. I had no idea that such anguish was prevalent among a good majority of the candidates. The good news is that just about all of them said they loved the weekend in the end and were glad that they stuck it out.

This indicates the value and wisdom of something we learned at the last National Encounter: When sponsoring someone, and prior to the weekend, we should bring them to an Ultreya or reunion mass or to your permanent group or even one of the team formation meetings. Here they can meet some Cursillistas, get acquainted and not feel so overwhelmed or alone or uncomfortable when they arrive Thursday night. It also indicates the importance of a sponsor explaining to their candidate what to expect on the weekend in as much detail as they ask for. And of course, we should tell them that they won't fully understand the beauty and blessing until they experience it for themselves.

The Cursillo weekend is meant to transform us and lead to a conversion of mind and heart. Thursday night prepares us for this.

We reviewed the Preliminary and Know Yourself Rollos, the Bankruptcy story, and the prodigal son and Three glances of Christ meditations, and the Stations of the cross. These were discussed in terms of their meaning and objective. In general, they are meant to get the new Cursillista to think about who they are and how they are living their life.

- To make them aware there is an effective method to everyone's search for happiness and love.
- What are their priorities and are they participating in God's plan for their life?
- To see what life is like with Christ and without Christ.
- To assess the assets and liabilities in our book of life.
- To search for God beginning inside your own heart.
- To examine our conscience and encourage reconciliation.
- To dwell on Our Father's love and mercy.

These ideas and exorcises influence their frame of mind and prepare them spiritually for what is to come next.

All the Second Touches are educational and inspiring. This one to me was exceptional. I urge everyone to consider attending next year's Second Touch on the first weekend of February 2021.

Spiritual Director's Reflection:

On the third Sunday in January, we heard when John the Baptist first saw Jesus he declared:

"Behold, the *Lamb of God*, who takes away the sin of the world."

His introduction of Jesus as a *lamb* definitively *consecrates* this prophetic sign of the *Lamb*.

Within the *most holy sacrifice of our Mass*, just before communion, the priest solemnly pronounces and makes holy these *same words* used by the Baptist to

announce the *Messiah* to Israel/us when he says:

"This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

Blessed are those who are called to the supper of the Lamb."

This first sentence is taken directly from the Gospel that day; the second comes from the Book of Revelation (19:9).

This ancient proclamation:

- Emphasizes the importance of this Jewish conception of the Lamb of God!
- Reveals the Lord in his Body both then and now -
- Announces the *real presence* of Jesus in the Eucharist to the entire world!

With these words, John *bears witness* to Jesus and expresses his faith in the Son of God, made man, before *all* who hear!

As disciples of Christ, we bear witness to Jesus and express our faith in the real presence of the Son of God every time we attend/participate at Mass and worthily receive the Eucharist.

Just like the Baptist, when the celebrant heralds "Behold, the Lamb of God!", within our Mass, he indicates the presence of Jesus – signifying that the bread and wine have been consecrated into the real presence of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus!

There is no more authentic and beautiful witness that *we could offer God* than that of our *willing/loving* attendance with *full participation* at Mass and through the reception of the Eucharist; not out of obligation, but out of true love and adoration for our God!

When we do -

- We become *surrounded* by God's angels and His Holy presence –
- And, in *return*, He *strengthens* us with His graces.

Earlier, I used its more formal name "The Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass" instead of just "the Mass" ... because the phrase contains nearly everything that we need to know in order to understand the very reason we should attend Mass as often as possible...

And, unless we come to understand this most fundamental/central aspect of the Mass, *nothing else makes sense*.

But, when we do ... <u>everything</u> makes sense!

That is, *The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass* is no less than Christ's *ultimate sacrifice*; it's not a:

- Figurative sacrifice
- Mere remembrance of something long ago

Nor is it a clever metaphor!

At every Mass we are witnessing and participating in the very real and very present sacrifice to God.

Every Mass is the sacrifice of the *Lamb of God* – Jesus' very life, His sufferings and His death; *it's Calvary continued*.

The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the most powerful atonement for our sins.

It's where:

 God forgives the venial sins which we have <u>not</u> confessed, providing for our negligence and omissions,

- o The power of Satan over us loosens.
- We afford the souls in Purgatory the greatest possible relief when we pray for them.
- We join our sufferings/sacrifices to Christ's, as we offer our lives/crosses—as *living* sacrifices in the spiritual worship of God each time we participate.
- We kneel amidst a multitude of holy angels who are always present at every sacrifice of the Mass with reverential awe.
- Jesus makes us children of the Father by being baptized in the blood of the Lamb

Most simply put – the Mass and Eucharist is *where* we "Behold the Lamb of God".

May we *acquire* that true and *reverential* awe of the angels and never become complacent to the extraordinary sacrifice of each Mass and the mysterious and miraculous gift of every Eucharist.

Here's the reason why...

For at the hour of our death, before God's throne – every Mass/Eucharist we have ever attended/participated/consumed, will be our greatest consolation and witness because every Mass goes both before us and with us to judgment ...pleading for our pardon!
