### Historian Report:

#### **Buffalo Cursillo History #25 February 2024 Cursillo and Renewal Movements**

After Vatican II, the Holy Spirit continued to breathe new life into the Church in the form of Renewal Movements. Rome and the Church in the U.S. were well aware of many of them.

Besides the Buffalo Cursillo Movement, the 1960s saw the growth of the Charismatic Renewal (Catholic Pentecostal Prayer Groups), Christian Family Movement, Marriage Encounter, SEARCH-Youth Retreat Program, and Christian Social Action Groups. Christian Life Communities or Catholic communes emerged like Cana Grace House Community in Alden (comprised of several families and religious) hosting retreats and workshops.

"The necessity for renewal is all around us, and it must begin "at home". By this I mean that it is the obligation of every one of us to renew ourselves and to do our part toward the renewal of the total Christian community...We are not in competition...different forms appeal to different types of people. The main thing is Church and Christ." - Fr. Barry Smith, "Buffalo Cursillo Newsletter", July, 1972

The 1970's were the heyday of Catholic Renewal as the Buffalo Diocese sought to meet the needs of over 900,000 Catholics in eight counties. Parishes numbered 300, Catholic Schools 200. Scripture classes for adults were being offered at some churches, colleges and at St. John Vianney Seminary. Better World Retreats were being offered to clergy and lay people locally and nationally.

In 1972, members of the Buffalo Cursillo Leaders' School made a Movement for a Better World Retreat instead of the annual Leaders' School Workshop.

In February 1973, the Secretariat sought to bring together several renewal groups to share their vision and future plans for renewal in the Diocese with each other and with Bishop Head. In June, a Better World Retreat was planned for the priests of the Diocese of St John Vianney Seminary.

The Secretariat was hoping for a deeper involvement in renewal movements (especially Cursillo) of the 300 pastors, over 2,500 religious and over 1,000 clergy-especially those in the Chancery, pastoral council members and board consultants. The Secretariat also sought to set up a list of all the local renewal groups and what they offered. Secretariat Minutes, Feb. 15, 1973

In 1970, Mother of Mercy Retreat House on Delaware Avenue was closed and sold by the Diocese. In 1971, the Sisters of St. Joseph opened O'Hern Center of Renewal at Main and Riley in Buffalo (former Bishop O'Hern Convent) now the Little Portion Friary for the homeless. O'Hern was the first religious intercommunity house in Buffalo. All founding members made Cursillo-six Sisters of St. Joseph and one Franciscan; Sr. Mary Ann Martin (W #5), Sr. Charlotte Riley (W #6), Sr. Therese Kinsel, OSF (W #7), Sr. Carol Norwalk (W #7), Sr. Martha Froning (W #8), Sr. Joan Wagner (W #8), and Sr. Leo Xavier Mesmer (W#19).

The sisters offered scripture classes, days of prayer for housewives and senior citizens, overnight retreats for adults and other events. O'Hern Center of Renewal closed in 1975.

In 1974, the Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity converted their novitiate building into Stella Niagara Center of Renewal in Lewiston. Founding members were St. Therese Kinsel, (W #7) and Sr. Mary Michael Hill (W #54). The Center offered directed retreats, group retreats, spiritual direction and a special program on Spiritual Formation of Lay Leaders in the Church with an emphasis on renewal. Fr. Pete Szafran (M #15) was the Center's first Spiritual Director.

The 1970's offered many vibrant opportunities to grow in Piety and Study. It was truly an embarrassment of riches for Catholics who sought to take advantage of these resources.

Buffalo Cursillo's Annual Second Touch Weekend, open to anyone who made a Cursillo, has been held at Stella Niagara Center of Renewal since 2017.
